Kudos for golf courses

Jackson Hole is well-represented in the "Best in State" rankings of Golf Digest magazine 2015-16 list of "America's Greatest Courses." The rankings listed the top five courses in each state, and Wyoming's list featured nothing but Jackson Hole venues. Snake River Sporting Club was named the state's No. 1 golf course, followed by Shooting Star, 3 Creek Ranch, Teton Pines and Jackson Hole Golf and Tennis. "We are honored to be recognized as the No. 1 golf course in Wyoming less than a year after reopening," said Jeff Heilbrun, general manager and chief operating officer of Snake River Sporting Club.
